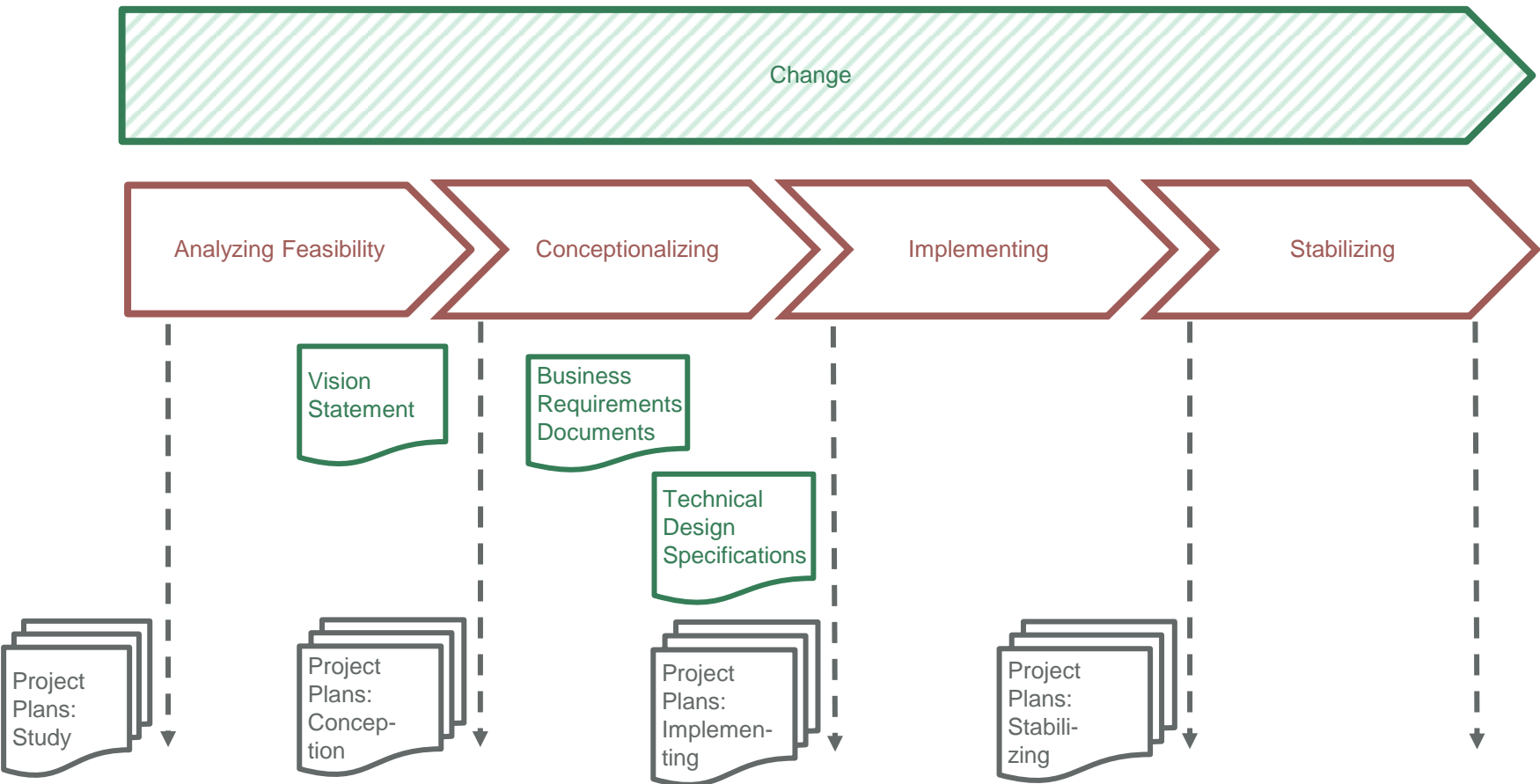
Parallel Management Approaches

- > Change, process & project management as well as business analysis are considered as distinct management approaches, which require specific roles, specific methods and terminologies.
- > On the one hand a differentiation between these approaches provides orientation, on the other hand in their practical application these approaches need to be combined.
- > In companies often different organizations, such as a Quality Management Department, a PM Office, a PcM Office or a Change Management Department, are responsible for these approaches.

Examples of Relationships between Approaches

- > A change is a chain of processes. Processes are objects of consideration of changes.
- > Projects deliver changes. Projects are subject to change and might require change management.
- > The process map provides the basis for identifying the project types of the project-oriented company.
- > Project initiation, project management, and program management are specific processes of the project-oriented company.
- > Business analysis provides business requirements as well as solution requirements, which are the basis for the definition of project objectives.

- > Common methods and a common terminology for process, project, and change management as well as business analysis contribute to the management quality of companies.
- > An integrated Management Office assures appropriate corporate governance.
- > It contributes to sustainable change, processes & project management as well as business analysis. By this it contributes indirectly to sustainable changes and business solutions.
- > Common values considering the principles of sustainable development are a common basis for management approaches and their role players.
- > Change owners, change managers, and change agents require change, process & project management as well as business analysis competences.
